Dear Parent/Carer,

From the 6th July until the 14th July, all Year 10 students will have the opportunity to join us on-site at the Central Academy, Newhall Street site for a two-hour PE or Creative Arts session.

The sessions will begin each day at 11am and will finish at 1pm and will be hosted by a member of the PE or Creative Arts department.

To sign up for a session, students will need to use the relevant Google form, which can be found here: <https://bit.ly/3euTOLH>

Students are only permitted to sign up for one day, there are a maximum of 24 places available for each day and places will be distributed on a first come, first served basis.

If a student does not have a place, please ensure that they do not attend school on that day, as they will not be allowed to take part in the session.

All students will enter the site through the normal student gate, which will be open at 10.50am. If they have signed up for a PE session, they will be greeted by their teacher on the MUGA. If they have signed up for a creative arts session, then they will go down the stairs by the lower playground and enter the creative arts department through this entrance.

Students who have signed up for the PE session are advised to attend in suitable sports clothing, this includes t-shirt, shorts, tracksuit bottoms and trainers, jeans are not permitted. It is also advised that students bring a drink of water with them for these sessions.

Students will not be able to use the changing rooms during this time, so it is vital that all students arrive on-site in their sportswear.

Students who have signed up for the creative arts session are not required to bring any equipment, as it will all be provided by the classroom teacher. However, students are advised that they should be aware of what creative arts session they have signed up for. For example, if they have selected a day when Mr Tear is on-site then they will be signing up for a drama session. Whereas, if they sign up for a day when Mrs Patel is on-site they will be signing up for a food science session.

All students and staff will be expected to continue to follow social distancing measures as per the government guidance to ensure our school community remains safe and healthy. If any students display behaviours that do not adhere to these measures, then they will be asked to leave the school site.
